

Packed and ready to go

Readybox – a subsidiary of Belgium based Transport and Project Logistics (TPL) – has signed a contractual agreement with Van Moer Rail and Exportpack to introduce its new Readybox Marine Packing service to customers in Antwerp from September 1, 2014.

Robert Vermetten (pictured), founder of Readybox, explained that in

Europe the demand for SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) certified packing is rising, because only a certified packing solution provides a guarantee that the content is protected against corrosion and that the case can be kept in safely storage for at least one year.

Should there be damage to the contents of SEI certified packages during that period, this would remain covered, added Vermetten, whereas these risks are always excluded in ordinary goods insurance.

Belgium based Exportpack has been SEI licensed for 15 years, where it "represents a valuable add-on to our existing services", while Van Moer Rail has experience in the handling, lashing and securing of project cargo, as well as the provision of logistics services.

Vermetten is optimistic that the integrated service provided by Readybox Marine Packing, which is built on TPL's expertise in project shipments, will add value to exporting companies and international freight forwarders.
